

Karl Lueger: Power is the "right" to identify the other as a certain other.

Karl Lueger: Techno-political lines (water, energy, power) territorialize the bio-body of the city.

Karl Lueger: Power - to target - operates in the distinction between

A folded ripple-stepping steel
membrane cuts across the
power-gridded space: Deteritorializing
resistance to power-determined allocation
of channel and reservoir.

Edging up, down, and across,
the smooth-breaking, water-veined
membrane wends our ways through
the structures of power:
A float-jumping multi-plane that
demands direct bodily engagement
with the other.

Not an anti-monument but a not-monument, the
membrane demands continual re-balancing of
our sensorium and elicits our own bodily
(re)enactment of Jewish historical suffering
and gifting to us.
